Dr. Saroja Wettasinghe holds B.Sc.(Hons) in Chemistry from Panjab University, India and a Ph.D in Archival Studies from University of London, U.K. She worked as an Assistant Archivist (Technical) from 1983-2004 and at present she is the Director National Archives of Sri Lanka.

She is a visiting lecturer of the University of Moratuwa, Sri Lanka and also in the faculty of training in records management and conservation for government officers, conducted by the National Archives of Sri Lanka.
